Total 1251 numbers of cases (including 02 Suo-motu Case, No. 305/33/8/2023 & 369/33/2/2024) were registered by NHRC related to incident reported for the State of Chhattisgarh, during the period January 2023 to December 2024. The list of these cases contains <b>41 pages.</b>
a.	The List of cases among them of custodial deaths/rapes/encounter killings.	a) Total 134 numbers of cases found under incident category "custodial death" (incident code - 301, 110 & 807). The list of these cases contains <b>11 pages.</b>  b) No case of custodial rape found on record.  c) Total 72 numbers of cases found registered under incident category "death in police encounter". The list of these cases contains <b>06 pages.</b>
b.	The list of cases among them dismissed by the NHRC with the case numbers.	Total 644 numbers of cases found dismissed in CMIS. The list of these cases contains <b>18 pages.</b>
c.	The list of cases disposed with directions by the NHRC.	Total 234 numbers of cases found disposed with directions in CMIS. The list of these cases contains <b>11 pages.</b>
d.	The list of cases dismissed in limini by the NHRC.	The information same as point 'b'
e.	The list of cases transferred to the State Human Rights Commission	Total 82 numbers of cases found transferred to the Chhattisgarh State Human Rights Commission. The list of these cases contains <b>03 pages.</b>

f.	The list of cases forwarded to the investigation wing by the NHRC.	According to CMIS, total 168 cases found moved to Investigation Division of the Commission. The list of these cases contains <b>10 pages</b> .
g.	The list of cases in which notices were issued by the NHRC.	As per CMIS, total 04 cases found in which notices were issued by the Commission to the authorities concerned. The Case Nos. are as follows: (i) 476/33/16/2020 (ii) 166/33/14/2019-PF (iii) 81/33/19/2022 (iv) 305/33/8/2023
h.	The list of cases in which recommendations were given by the NHRC.	There is no device available in CMIS to trace the cases in which Commission made recommendations. However, the details of cases may be checked from <a href="http://hrcnet.nic.in">hrcnet.nic.in</a> by entering case number.
i.	The list of cases in which Action Taken Report have been received by the NHRC.	To find out the cases in which action taken report is received by the Commission, a large number of cases required to be checked thus compilation of this voluminous information is bound to divert disproportionately the resources (manpower) of the Commission, to the extent to disrupt its routine functioning, hence it is regretted that the Commission is constrained to deny this information as per section 7(9) of the RTI Act. However, the details of action taken report may be checked by going through the proceedings of the Commission, which may be checked at <a href="http://hrcnet.nic.in">hrcnet.nic.in</a> by entering case number.
j.	The list of cases where NHRC recommended compensation for the victims of human rights violation.	As per CMIS, total 22 cases found in which NHRC recommended compensation. The list of these cases contains <b>02 pages</b> .
