Subject: An RTI application dated 24.02.2025 received in the Commission on 27.02.2025, filed under Right to Information Act, 2005 by S. K. Venkat Raman.

Sir/Madam,

I am to refer to the above mentioned RTI application and to furnish point-wise information as under:

Point No.	Information sought	Response
1.	List of complaints transferred to the NHRC from Jammu & Kashmir, SHRC and list of all compliant sent to NHRC or taken Suo-motu by NHRC w.e.f January 2023 to December 2024.	Total 714 numbers of cases were received by NHRC on transfer from J&K SHRC and registered afresh in the NHRC in the year 2024. The list of these cases contains 57 pages. As regard compliance/reports received by the Commission in these cases, it is to clarify that the information sought relate to large number of cases as such for the compilation of the information a number of case files are required to be retrieved and examined. The compilation of this voluminous information, is bound to divert disproportionately the resources (manpower) of the Commission, to the extent to disrupt its routine functioning, hence it is regretted that the Commission is constrained to deny this information as per section 7(9) of the RTI Act. However, you may, if so desired, seek copies of documents of any of these cases by filing separate RTI application for each case. As per Complaint Management Information System of the Commission, no suo-motu case found registered during the period January, 2023 to December, 2024, pertaining to J&K State.
a.	The List of cases among them of custodial deaths/rapes/encounter killings.	As per CMIS record the cases received in NHRC on transfer from the SHRC, J&K, were registered under the single incident code i.e. 6000 (Cases of erstwhile JK SHRC). As a result, the cases cannot be traced incident categories-wise i.e custodial death/rape/encounter killing etc. However, the details of these 714 cases may be checked from hrcnet.nic.in by entering case number.
b.	The list of cases among them dismissed by the NHRC with the case numbers.	
c.	The list of cases disposed with directions by the NHRC.	No such case has been found under these action categories in CMIS.
d.	The list of cases dismissed in limini by the NHRC.

Point No.	Information sought	Response
c.	The list of cases forwarded to the investigation wing by the NHRC.	According to CMIS, total 04 number of cases found moved to Investigation Division of the Commission. The case Nos. are as follows: (i) 199/9/5/2024-JK (ii) 358/9/3/2024-JK (iii) 686/9/3/2024-JK (iv) 347/9/5/2024-JK
f.	The list of cases in which notices were issues by the NHRC.	Almost in all the cases notices were issued by the Commission to the authorities concerned and may be checked at hrcnet.nic.in by entering case number.
g.	The list of cases in which recommendations were given by the NHRC.	There is no device available in CMIS to trace the cases in which the Commission made recommendations. However, the details of these cases may be checked from hrcnet.nic.in by entering case number.
h.	The list of cases in which Action Taken Report have been received by the NHRC.	To find out the cases in which action taken report is received by the Commission, a large number of cases required to be checked thus compilation of this voluminous information is bound to divert disproportionately the resources (manpower) of the Commission, to the extent to disrupt its routine functioning, hence it is regretted that the Commission is constrained to deny this information as per section 7(9) of the RTI Act. However, the details of action taken report may be checked by going through the proceedings of the Commission, which may be checked at hrcnet.nic.in by entering case number.
i.	The list of cases where NHRC recommended compensation for the victims of human rights violation.	As per CMIS record, no case has been found under this action category.

2. The information sought i.e list of cases mentioned in Point 1 above contains 57 pages.
